

SMART LICENCING CENTRES: EXAMINERS

The Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport (GDRT) intends to expand the establishment of Smart Licencing Centres in the areas within or near Townships, Informal Settlements and Hostels (TISH), utilising the existing infrastructure such as township malls, post offices and municipal facilities.

GDRT will develop, implement and roll out Licensing Service Centres in the TISH communities to improve service delivery whilst creating socio-economic benefits.

The GDRT has partnered with a talent acquisition service provider to conduct the response handling of applications for suitable candidates to potentially fill positions available at the approved Smart Licencing Centres.
